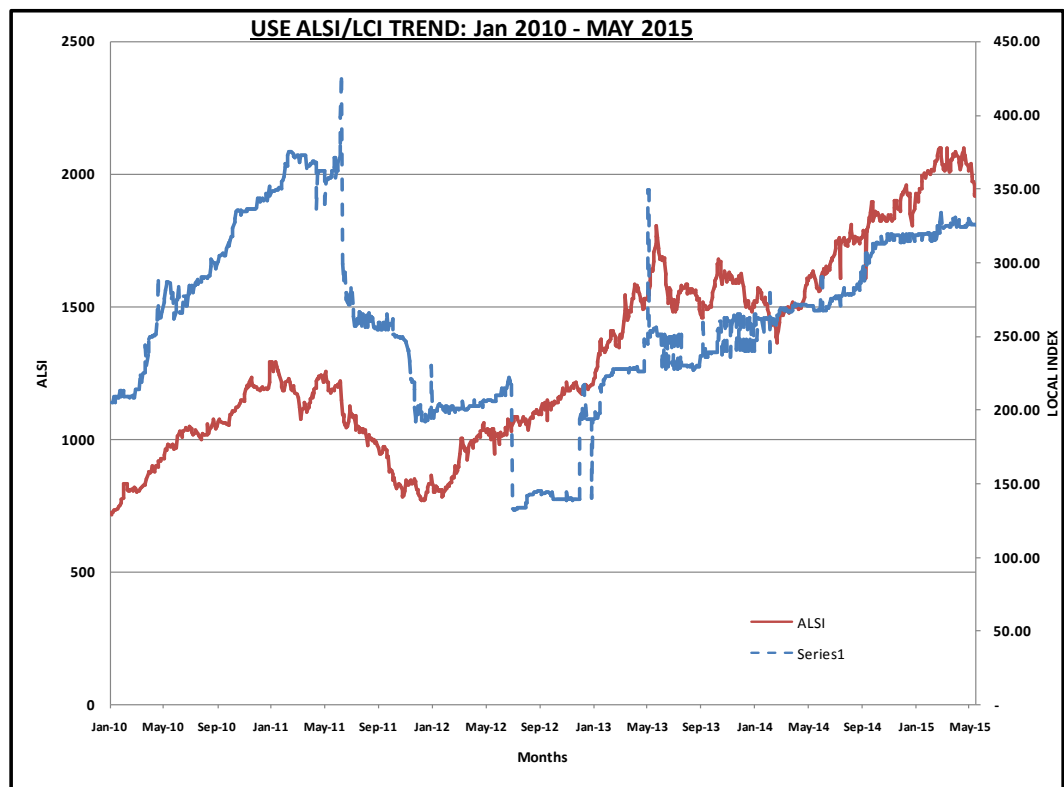

The week's session closed with the ALSI Index at 1895.35 down by 18.43 basis points while the LSI closed at 333.15 up by 55.23 basis points. 6 Stocks advanced while 5 stocks declined; an advance to decline ratio of 6:5. 5 stocks remained flat during the session.

The most active counters by volume were UMEME and STANBIC. The counters that had the largest advances were EABL and KCB. The largest decliners were CENT and UCHM.

The turnover during this period stood at 4,421,123,284 more than 1,122,179,306 that was recorded the previous week. The number of shares traded stood at 9,735,925 greater than 6,221,220 that were traded the previous week.
